Competition Rules & Regulation

Relevant Badminton World Federation Regulations shall be applicable to this competition.

Clothing & Advertising

Clothing and advertising will be permitted in accordance with the competition regulations of Badminton World Federation.(GCR 20 - 24)

The player's name on the back of clothing shall be identical with the name registered as the Last Name (or an abbreviation thereof) in the BWF Player database. Last Name is defined as the family name, surname or similar name under the respective naming protocol of the Member count. (GCR 23.3)

MANDATORY CLOTHING REGULATIONS

- 1. Name of player is MANDATORY from the first day of the event.
- 2. From Quarter Finals onwards, doubles partners must wear clothing of the same colour.
- 3. From Quarter Finals onwards, opposing players must wear clothing of significantly different colors.

PREPARATIONS FOR THE QUARTER FINALS ONWARDS

Kindly prepare sets of clothing of significantly different colors

Where both Players / Pairs have the same or no ranking, the Player or Pair listed lower in the first M&Q list Report made for the competition will be required to change the colour of clothing. (GCR 21.6., BWF STATUTES Section 5.1.)

· Lettering shall be in CAPITAL LETTERS in the ROMAN ALPHABET and shall be placed,

NTOMs close to horizontal as possible, the the top of the shirt.







	Lettering must be a minimum height of <u>6 centimeters</u> and a maximum height of <u>10 centimeters</u> . (6 cm to 10 cm)				
	 Lettering sequence on the shirt from top to bottom shall be; Player Name Country Name (<u>5 cm</u> if present) Advertisement (<u>5 cm</u> if present) 				
Dispute	In case of any dispute regarding the tournament, the rights of final decision shall go to the referee.				
On Court Doctor	On Court Doctor will be on duty throughout the competition at the tournament Venue.				
	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.				
Doping Control	Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).
